- Prestige: Election to the National Academy of Medicine (NAM) is one of the highest honors in the fields of health and medicine. It recognizes individuals for outstanding professional achievement and commitment to service in advancing medical science, healthcare, and public health.
- Annual Elections: Up to 90 U.S. members and 10 international members are elected each year.
- Who Can Nominate: Only current NAM members may submit nominations.
- Confidentiality: **Nominations are privileged and confidential. Campaigning is strictly prohibited.**

NAM members are affiliated with one of 43 major fields spanning biomedical science, health, and medicine. These are grouped into thematic sections such as:

- Neurosciences, Physiology, and Pharmacology
- Internal Medicine, Pathology, and Dermatology
- Pediatrics and Obstetrics/Gynecology
- Surgery, Surgical Subspecialties, Anesthesiology, Radiology, Nuclear Medicine, Radiation Oncology, and Ophthalmology
- Psychiatry and Neurology
- Family Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Physical Medicine, and Rehabilitation
- Public Health, Biostatistics, and Epidemiology
- Dentistry, Nutrition, Nursing, Allied Health Professions, Pharmacy, and Veterinary Medicine
